

Additional Questions, Romans 11:25-36

1. Romans 11:28b-29 NLT regarding Israel reads: “Yet they are still the people He loves because He chose their ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. For God’s gifts and His call can never be withdrawn.” What does the fact that God will one day fulfill His promises to the patriarchs of Israel mean to you personally?
2. The Doxology (defined as a “short hymn of praise to God”) found in verses 33-36 closes Chapters 9-11 which have focused on Israel. Read it over several times and then pray these words back to God. Write out your prayer, using these words of Scripture or write your own praise to God based on what He has shown you in these chapters and/or how He has been working in your life.
