

Romans 16 Additional Questions

The definition of the word “commend” is: praise formally or officially, or present as suitable for approval or acceptance.

1) Search Romans 16:1-13 and write down the names of those Paul commends to the believers at Rome and what words of praise he writes about them.

2) Imagine that you were writing a letter to a dear friend who lives far away. What words of commendation would you say about the ladies you have come to know through this study? Be specific, using their names and what they have meant to you.

3) Read Matthew 25:14-30 for context. Verse 21 (NIV) reads: His master replied, “Well done, good and faithful servant.” Think about what it would mean to hear those words of commendation from Jesus some day and write down your thoughts. Ask the Holy Spirit’s help to live so that you might hear those words from your Savior. Consider writing out your prayer.
