

Romans 15:1-13 Additional Questions

Romans 15:4 (NIV) “For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope.”

This week’s Additional Questions will help us dig deep into the Scriptures to apply this verse and help cement it in our hearts and minds. Prayerfully read the Scripture passages suggested below and write down any thoughts that inspire you to endure trials and/or give you encouragement and hope:

1. Joseph (Genesis 37:13-28, 36, Chapter 39:1-23, 40:1-23, 41:1-46, 50:15-21)

2. The “Three Hebrew Children” (Daniel 3:8-30)

3. Daniel (Daniel 6:1-23)

4. What other words found in your Bible, written so long ago, give you hope today? Write some of them down, along with any thoughts that come to your mind and heart. Ask the Holy Spirit to bring these words alive to you this week (see Hebrews 4:12 NIV). Consider memorizing a portion that is especially meaningful.
